- Meals:** Meals will begin with breakfast on Saturday and will conclude with breakfast on Sunday. Please allow time for your students to pick-up dinner Friday night before arriving.

RULES

All participants and their parents/guardians must be aware of the rules for VISION. Failing to adhere to the following rules could result in the students' removal from the event.

1. Every student is required to attend the entire weekend.
2. Students are to stay with their group leader at ALL times.
3. Students must attend all sessions.
4. Students must be in rooms and have lights out at the assigned times.
5. Drugs, alcohol, tobacco, firearms, or weapons are not permitted.
6. iPods, mp3 players, CD players, clock radios, televisions, gaming systems, pagers, cell phones, laser pointers, or any other type of electronic device are not allowed.
7. Students must dress appropriately.
8. Any forms of Public Displays of Affection (PDA) are not allowed.
9. Under NO circumstances are students of differing genders allowed to be in or near each other's rooms.
10. Students who are ill or injured should contact their leader immediately.
11. Churches are responsible for damage to campus/facilities.
12. Students are to stay in assigned rooms.

THE MUST READ LIST

- **REGISTRATION DEADLINES**
 - Your Registration/Medical Release Forms must be turned into the BSU office by March 15, 2012. All last minute Registration/Medical Release Forms and changes must be turned into the BSU office by March 29, 2012! After March 15 your students are not guaranteed a t-shirt.
 - No registrations will be accepted after March 29, 2012.

- **PAYMENT**
 - Payments may be made by cash or check, but please do not send cash in the mail. All checks are to be made payable to YOUR CHURCH and then the church will make a payment to Mizzou BSU Ministries.

- **CHURCH CONTACT PERSON FORM**
 - Only one contact person form needs to be submitted for each church group that is attending VISION. The contact person, in most cases, is the youth leader who will accompany the students to the retreat.

- **REGISTRATION FORMS**
 - Every student and leader must complete a Registration Form and Medical Release Form. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Registration will take place in the dining hall at Camp Rising Sun. Our leaders will be serving as greeters near the entrance.

REGISTRATION:

The contact person (or representative) will come to the central registration table to pick up his/her group's packet. Materials and t-shirts will be given out in the registration packet. The contact person should have a copy of their final attendance list.

Once the contact person has picked up the registration packet, he/she will distribute the materials to the students, and then accompany them to their respective rooms.

After vehicles are unloaded, students are free to get settled into their rooms. They should head to the auditorium by 8 PM for the first large group session.
